

Google Pixel Emergency Contact

To set up emergency contacts on a Google Pixel, you'll use the Personal Safety app to add or manage your emergency information and contacts. This includes medical information and contacts that can be accessed even when your phone is locked. You can also use the Emergency SOS feature to quickly connect with help in an emergency.

Steps to add emergency contacts:

1. **Open the Personal Safety app:** You can find it in your app drawer.
2. **Tap "Your info":** This will allow you to manage your personal information, including emergency contacts.
3. **Tap "Emergency contacts":** This section allows you to add or manage your emergency contacts.
4. **Tap "Add contact":** Choose from your existing contacts to add them as an emergency contact.
